

PREMIO MÉXICO DE CIENCIA Y TECNOLOGÍA 2016



Call for Nominations

The Mexican Government calls on scientific institutions of Central America, South America, the Caribbean, Spain and Portugal to nominate candidates for the **PREMIO MÉXICO DE CIENCIA Y TECNOLOGÍA 2016**

Rules and Guidelines

- a. The PRIZE is awarded to a person of recognized professional prestige who has made a significant contribution to universal scientific knowledge, technological advances or the development of the social sciences; who has been recognized for the international impact of his or her contributions; for the creation of a school among some researchers, or for contributions to the training of human resources; and who has made such efforts fundamentally in one or more countries of the region covered by this call.
- b. It is up to the jury, proposed by the Consejo de Premiación del Premio México, to choose the winner of the PRIZE, who will receive \$762,666.00 (seven hundred sixty-two thousand six hundred sixty-six 00/100 Mexican pesos), a medal and a diploma.
- c. The decision of the jury is final and the PRIZE cannot be divided or transferable.
- d. The PRIZE will be awarded at an official ceremony by the President of Mexico.
- e. The candidates must hold a nationality of a Central American, South American or Caribbean country, Spain or Portugal, and residence in one of these countries. Nominations of Mexican citizens will not be accepted.
- f. The candidate must be nominated by a scientific, technological and/or academic institutions of the countries mentioned in the previous point. Personal nominations will not be considered.
- g. All institutional proposals may be submitted in original form, signed by the highest authority. Should be sent, by separate and electronic format, the following documents: candidate's curriculum, a description of their more relevant and impact work; sheets of their own books, articles in specialized journals, technical reports, patents and other relevant documents.
- h. The documents received will not be returned to the nominating institutions, nor shall they be considered for the PRIZE on future calls.
- i. The deadline for all submissions and related documents is October 15, 2016.
- j. The PRIZE shall be presented on the date and place designated by the Consejo de Premiación del Premio México.
- k. The winner of the PRIZE will dictate a series of lectures at different scientific and technological research institutions in Mexico during the 15 days following the ceremony at which the PRIZE is awarded.
